- 5. Does your school offer any special programs such as: independent study, study abroad, joint programs, with nearby colleges?
- 6. Are there clubs for dance, drama, or debate?
- 7. Is there a band, orchestra, chorus, radio station, or TV station?
- 8. Does your school have fraternities or sororities?

ADMISSIONS

- 1. What are the admissions requirements: ACT or SAT, interview, class rank, high school GPA, recommendations?
- 2. What are the average SAT or ACT scores for incoming freshmen?
- 3. What are the minimum acceptable scores?
- 4. What are the admissions deadlines? Rolling, Early admissions, or deferred admissions?
- 5. Are there special requirements for certain programs such as: audition, portfolio, interviews, or tests?
- 6. What is the application fee?
- 7. What percent of applicants are accepted?
- 8. When will your school notify students on their admissions status?

CAMPUS

- 1. What is the campus setting: urban, suburban, or rural?
- 2. What do students do on evenings and weekends?
- 3. What do students like most about your college? Is there anything you are aware of that they don't like?
- 4. How large is the campus?
- 5. Are other colleges nearby?
- 6. What are the local cultural and social attractions?
- 7. Is there public transportation available?

COST/FINANCIAL AID

- 5. What is the average award summary package?
