Questions to ask college representatives

GENERAL

1. How accessible are faculty to students?
2. If you are anxious to do research, ask if that is available to undergraduate students and how?
3. What degrees are offered? Majors? Minors? Electives?
4. What is your school known for?
5. Does your school offer any special programs such as: independent study, study abroad, joint programs, with nearby colleges?
6. Are there clubs for dance, drama, or debate?
7. Is there a band, orchestra, chorus, radio station, or TV station?
8. Does your school have fraternities or sororities?

ADMISSIONS

1. What are the admissions requirements: ACT or SAT, interview, class rank, high school GPA, recommendations?
2. What are the average SAT or ACT scores for incoming freshmen?
3. What are the minimum acceptable scores?
4. What are the admissions deadlines? Rolling, Early admissions, or deferred admissions?
5. Are there special requirements for certain programs such as: audition, portfolio, interviews, or tests?
6. What is the application fee?
7. What percent of applicants are accepted?
8. When will your school notify students on their admissions status?

CAMPUS

1. What is the campus setting: urban, suburban, or rural?
2. What do students do on evenings and weekends?
3. What do students like most about your college? Is there anything you are aware of that they don't like?
4. How large is the campus?
5. Are other colleges nearby?
6. What are the local cultural and social attractions?
7. Is there public transportation available?

COST/FINANCIAL AID

1. What are charges for tuition, rooms, and meals?
2. Are different meal plans available?
3. Is a down payment required? If yes, when, and how much?
4. Are there any special payment plans?
5. What is the average award summary package?
6. Is there any Institutional Aid offered? If yes, what is the average amount?

COUNSELING

1. Is personal or psychological counseling?
2. Is financial counseling available?
3. Is career counseling available?
4. What supports do you have for first generation students?
5. What supports do you have for students with IEP's?
